Explanatory Notes

1. Name and registered address of the Organisation

is the name and address of the Organisation's registered office as recorded in the Companies Registry of the HKSAR if the Organisation is a company incorporated under the Companies Ordinance (Cap.622) in Hong Kong. For a Government Department, it is the name and address of the Government Department. For a sole-proprietorship business, the name of the Organisation shall be the name of its sole-proprietor and the name of the business marked on its business registration certificate issued under the Business Registration Ordinance (Cap. 310) while the address shall be the address shown on the same certificate.

2. HKIAS Authorised Representative

is the person nominated by an inspection body to represent it in all matters affecting the day to day maintenance of accreditation status. He/She is therefore responsible for liaison with HKAS Executive. The roles and responsibilities of authorised representatives are described formally in HKAS 002.

HKAS Executive recommends that an inspection body should nominate an individual as the authorised representative of appropriate seniority who has a close appreciation of its activities and also a direct interest and influence in the standard of its performance.

3. Name of Inspection Body

is the name used by the Organisation to identify the inspection body which performs the inspection activities under or proposed for accreditation.

4. Inspection Field

is a name used by HKAS to represent a branch of inspection for which HKAS provides accreditation under HKIAS. An up-to-date list of inspection fields under HKIAS can be obtained on HKAS website at www.hkas.gov.hk.
